



PERIPHERAL SATELLITE CENTER POSTINGS OF INTERNS FOR COMPREHENSIVE DENTAL CARE FOR COMMUNITY- June 2nd 2016



Each batch of interns during their clinical posting in the Department of Public Health Dentistry are posted in the Satellite centers of Pullurampara and Meenchanda of KMCT Dental College. All the interns are posted for a period of 1 to weeks at these centers on rotation. The Satellite center posting is meant to help interns receive additional clinical training and exposure as well as training in provision of comprehensive Dental Care for the community. The focus of this care is for rural community who have limited access to Dental Care. On June 2nd 2016 the current batch of 58 interns began their postings at these centers on rotation. They are guided by deputed BDS and MDS faculty from the Department of Public Health Dentistry posted in these centers.

The skit depicted the life of college students and the peer pressures and family background, by which teenagers are forced to take up the habit of tobacco use. The children were divided into groups of 10 each, based on their age. The faculty and students of KMCT Dental College, conducted the counselling sessions. The children got an opportunity to discuss and interact directly with the faculty, Post graduate and Undergraduate students and clear their existing views and concepts on Tobacco and its use.
