WATER PURIFICATION PROCESS FIELD VISIT FOR UG STUDENTS TO KOOLIMAD WATER PURIFICATION PLANT-June 16th 2017



In order to get a deeper understanding about the harmful effects of water borne diseases and the role that Potable drinking water plays in maintaining human health, a visit to Koolimad water purification center was organized by **Department of Public Health Dentistry** in association with and permission from Executive Engineer of Kerala Water Authority, Malaparamba, Kozhikode on June 16th 2017. As part of their academic curriculum, the batch of Final Year part undergraduate students were taken for a field visit to **Koolimad Water Purification Center**to observe the different methods **of Large scale purification** of water. A total of 47 students were taken in KMCT Dental College bus to Koolimad water purification center by 9 am. The students were accompanied by two faculty from Department of Public Health Dentistry. The staff at Koolimad plant received the students and took the team to observe the processof large scale purification of raw water of Chaliyarriver. The students were able to observe the process of **Rapid sand filtration** method which was followed by observation of method of **Chlorination**. The students also had an interactive session with the center staff where their doubts were cleared. The visit concluded by 1 pm.







PERIPHERAL SATELLITE CENTER POSTINGS OF INTERNS FOR COMPREHENSIVE DENTAL CARE FOR COMMUNITY- June 6th 2017



Each batch of interns during their clinical posting in the Department of Public Health Dentistry are posted in the Satellite centers of Pullurampara and Meenchanda of KMCT Dental College.
