



PERIPHERAL SATELLITE CENTER POSTINGS OF INTERNS FOR COMPREHENSIVE DENTAL CARE FOR COMMUNITY- June 2nd 2019



Each batch of interns during their clinical posting in the Department of Public Health Dentistry are posted in the Satellite centers of Mavoor and Meenchanda of KMCT Dental College. All the interns are posted for a period of 1 to weeks at these centers on rotation. The Satellite center posting is meant to help interns receive additional clinical training and exposure as well as training in provision of comprehensive Dental Care for the community. The focus of this care is for rural community who have limited access to Dental Care. On June 2nd2019 the current batch of 73 interns began their postings at these centers on rotation.
