
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

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Summary:

Dr Riaz Abdullah is a professor of oral pathology in Yenopoya dental college He is very keen in grabbing the grant from different organizations and government bodies . The purpose of this seminar is to give the participant guidance on how to organize a research proposal in order maximize chances to obtain the desired funding. Key aspects were highlighted and practical tips were emphasized. As research budgets are being reduced by many funding agencies and more researchers are competing for it, it is becoming increasingly important to be able to write a grant proposal of high quality.

The 2 most challenging tasks that every investigator faced in the present scenario were to secure grants and publish papers. He also suggested that in the current funding environment, preparing an outstanding grant proposal is critical, as even minute deficiencies can potentially lead to rejection. Furthermore, publications in reputable journals were crucial to disseminate research findings and promote career development.

This seminar emphasized basically the tips and tricks for successfully writing a Grants proposal to the staffs, students and PGs of KMCT Dental College. This was organised by the Dept. of Pedodontics, KMCT Dental College. A total of 38 participants actively attended the session.

Then only our research will receive a global acceptance and recognition.
